Re: Permitting process for the renovation of existing homes or businesses.

1. Provide a detail drawing for plan review of the building to be renovated within 90 days. Drawing to including the following details:

> Measurements of the building to scale showing any structural components to be replaced.

Room sizes, Door sizes, Window sizes,

Plumbing fixture layout showing all plumbing to be replaced including piping. Electrical layout showing switches, receptables, electrical service meter and service disconnect.

Type of HVAC being used and location of window units/mini-splits if applicable.

- 2. Once a plan review is completed, approved permits can be purchased by a licensed contractor or a home owner that qualifies for the affidavit claiming exemption from Licensure. See attached affidavit.
- 3. Once all permits are purchased by all sub-contractors (contractor, electrician, plumber, HVAC as applicable) the work can proceed.
- 4. Inspections must be call in by the Contractor or Sub-Contractors doing the work. The following is an example of required inspections:
 - Temporary Power Pole Inspection (If needed)
 - Plumbing Rough-in (Do not cover pipes before inspection) Note: If your house is on piers a plumbing rough-in inspection will be done at open wall phase.
 - PRE-slab inspection (Call for inspection before any concrete is poured)
 - Open Wall Inspection Includes: Building, Plumbing, Mechanical and Electrical inspections.

(Call for inspection before insulation or wall sheathing is installed.)

- Electrical Service Inspection (Call when electrical system is ready to be energized.)
- Final Inspection Includes: Building, Plumbing, Mechanical, and Electrical inspections (Call before moving in)
